

ANNOUNCEMENT of SIR-scholarship 2024

Purpose/Intention	The Scientist-in-Residence-program invites young scientists from different disciplines to a one-month work stay in Salzburg - "city of knowledge". A diverse cultural landscape as well as university and non-university research institutions significantly shape the profile of the city of Salzburg and give it international appeal. The SIR scholarship offers young scientists the space for interdisciplinary collaborations, intensifying the posing of questions and the exchange of perspectives and expertise.
	The intention of the program is to give international young scientists access to Salzburg's knowledge institutions, to promote sustainable networking and thus to initiate and carry out new projects.
	The willingness and curiosity for dialogue and cooperation with researchers, as well as with cultural and knowledge institutions is required. It is explicitly desired to present your own focus of activity to the general public in the form of at least one publicly accessible event and other means of knowledge communication (e.g. public relations activities, interviews, etc.).
Target group	Eligible to apply are young scientists who have a PhD or postdoc position at a university institution or are employed at a non- university research institution outside of Austria, or who can prove several years of scientific work. The applicant must not be older than 45 years and must have their main place of residence outside of Austria (certificate of registration).
Number of scholarships	Up to 10 scholarships annually
Duration of scholarship	Duration 1 month; in justifiable cases 2 months
	The SIR scholarship is an attendance scholarship; the scholarship holders must spend at least three quarters of the scholarship period in the city of Salzburg.
Scholarship amount	Endowment of EUR 1,000 each, plus a contribution to travel expenses (EUR 200 for Europe; EUR 500 for other continents) and free accommodation in the apartment "Tobias" (35 m ²).
	Additional funding for the research stay must be disclosed before the start of the residency and can lead to a reduction in the scholarship.
Filing deadline	Call I/24: 31 May 2023 for a stay in the first half of 2024
	Call II/24: 31 October 2023 for a stay in the second half of 2024.

	3. Short description of the research interest and the planned activity in the knowledge institution (max. 1 page DIN A4 format)
	 Letter of Intent (LoI) from the knowledge institution with which cooperation is to take place, including confirmation that a workplace will be made available.
	5. Curriculum Vitae
	6. Certificate of registration
	7. If available: list of publications

	Call II/24: by 1 February 2024
	Only complete applications will be processed. All applicants will be informed of the result in writing. There is no verbal justification for the decision. Applications that are not submitted by the deadline or applications with incomplete documents cannot be considered.
	MA 2 – Kultur, Bildung und Wissen reserves the right to make subsequent nominations in justified cases or in case there is free capacity.
Evidence	By accepting the scholarship, the scholarship holder undertakes to submit a short report (max. 3 pages DIN A4 format) on the work results to MA 2 – Kultur, Bildung und Wissen no later than three months after the end of the scholarship.
